IEPA Loan Review Process

Piggush went through the Loan Program Proposed Project Plan submitted Jan. 3, 2020 for construction of a new 125,000-gallon elevated water tower.

Water Rate Analysis

Village Property on West Jackson

The homeowner at 216 West Jackson has asked to put gravel down on the empty lot west of his property/driveway for parking a camper. The Board proposed an agreement be signed that he can put the gravel down at his expense and mow the vacant lot in return, stipulating that if the property was to sell, the gravel would need to be removed.

Any Other Business

The American Legion has requested a raffle license for a 'Queen of Hearts' raffle. An annual license will be issued at the same rate as other raffles for that purpose.
