**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SPENDING AUTHORITY
FOR THE VILLAGE OF CULLOM EMPLOYEES AND PRESIDENT**

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cullom, Livingston County, Illinois (the "Village"), find it in the best interest of the Village to establish discretionary spending authority for Village employees and the Village President;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Cullom, Livingston County, Illinois, as follows:

SECTION 1. A Village employee may purchase routine operating supplies and consumables (including, without limitation, office supplies, fuel, and minor maintenance items) not exceeding \$ 250.00 per transaction without the prior approval of the Village President or the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 2. The Village President is authorized to make or approve purchases and contracts not exceeding \$2,500.00 per transaction without the prior approval of the Board of Trustees. Any purchase or contract in excess of that amount shall require the approval of the Board of Trustees.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Ordinance is held to be invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are repealed insofar as they conflict.

SECTION 5. The Clerk is directed by the corporate authorities to publish this Ordinance in pamphlet form. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect after its passage and publication in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/1-2-4.


